Eve's full name is Napharat Manovan, she is 17 years old and loves to play the drums and guitar, music and sport are her favorite hobbies., she likes to cook, speaks English well, and even can speak a little bit of French.

Eve is from a very poor Thai family, and was abandoned by her Mother before she was 3 years old. Her father has remained a part of her life, which is rare in such situations, but has not had the resources or skills to properly provide for her. At 3 years old, Eve went to live with her Thai Aunt and Swiss Uncle, who raised her and made sure all her needs were met. Tragically her Aunt and Uncle were killed in an accident and Eve lost that steady and positive influence in her life.

Eve's father lives in a remote village away from the city, where there is not access to education, he does not have the ability to fully provide for Eve and was struggling to find a way to keep her in school in Chiang Rai. Without help Eve would not continue her education and manifest her full potential. Eve is attending her last year at CVK Christian School in Chiang Rai and will write entrance exams for University in February of 2018.

With your support Eve's future looks very bright, she is a motivated young lady, and she is extremely helpful to us and the other girls in our care. When we met Eve, and spent some time with her, we realized how talented and bright she is and that if we could continue what her aunt and uncle started, Eve would not waste the opportunity to excel in life.
